	Description	Rcmd. Timing *	Contributor
Welcome	Open the meeting with prayer; give purpose & overview of G7	5 min	President or VP
① Gospel	Scripture & short devotional to frame up the meeting	5 min	Current member
② Group	Recognize visitors; introduce yourselves & share something personal	10-15 min	All attendees
③ Grade	Reiterate shared networking goals; report on progress; delegate action steps for follow-up	10 min	President or VP
④ God	1-3 testimonies for building faith & trust among community	5-10 min	Current member(s)
5 Grow	Educational moment for personal, professional, and/or spiritual growth	5-10 min	Current member or outside speaker
6 Get	Share your business elevator pitch & ask of fellow members	10-20 min	All attendees
⑦ Give	Briefly call out whose "Gets" you can support with referral etc.	5-10 min	All attendees
Closing	Announcements & reminders; close with prayer or encouragement	5 min	President or VP

* Total meeting time is 60 to 90 minutes, depending on chapter size. Adjust the recommended time ranges above to fit the needs of your chapter. Value everyone's time by starting & ending overall on schedule.

Tips for Meeting Best Practice:

- Have fun! Resist the urge to use this agenda as a mere checklist. Make the 7 G's work for you!
 G7 meetings are an energizing & uplifting part of the business life for all members! As able, allow 15 minutes before and/or afterwards for open networking & fellowship.
- ✓ Come prepared: Every member arrives with: a) the *Grow by Giving*[™] mindset, ready to serve needs of others, b) personal guest invited to join G7, and c) pitch & feasible "Gets" for others to support you.
- ✓ Be coordinated: For presentational segments (Gospel, God, & Grow), speakers are aligned in advance. Leaders, come ready to fulfill your chapter responsibilities.
- Meet individually with one another: Every month, schedule 1-on-1s or triads with other members between chapter meetings to build trust & seek referrals.
